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Why OLF is Being Discontinued





Now with the addition of the Special Arbitration Forum, Total Recovery Solution (TRS[®]) contains all of AF's programs prompting the discontinuation of Online Filing (OLF) later this year.

Open, unheard cases will have to be resubmitted in TRS. This includes cases that have been deferred. In preparation for the move, you are asked to refile your OLF cases in TRS[®].

AF will initiate the import of Online Filing (OLF) cases to TRS® on September 9, 2024.

Once the import is complete, a notification is sent to your company's global address. To access the case, click the hyperlink.

You can also access the TRS® case by entering the claim or docket number in the field provided.

How to Refile and Submit a Case in TRS

Quick Tips



Not all claim information will migrate from OLF to TRS. You will need to re-enter information from certain sections, such as **Company-Paid Damages**.


Evidence from OLF will migrate to TRS and will be located in **Evidence Manager**. You are required to attach evidence to relevant workflow steps.

Review each workflow step carefully and enter claims information where required before submitting the case to TRS.

Enter Filing



After entering the OLF docket number or claim number, the case will appear on your worklist. From the filter options, select **OLF to TRS Cases**. By selecting this filter, only migrated OLF to TRS cases will appear in the Worklist.




Special Workflow Steps



Incident Details and My Party Information Workflow Step

In some cases, claims information will be defaulted into specific fields. You will need to verify the accuracy of this information.

To edit a field, select the below icon in red. Using the drop-down arrow, select the correct Right of Recovery.



Selecting the tab imports the selected coverage and allows you to bypass the next workflow step titled “Select Coverages.”


